As well as the year group booklets, the following are suggestions for different activities for the children

English	<p>Instructions</p> <p>Think of something you are good at doing. (Making a sandwich, baking a cake, making a paper aeroplane etc) Write a set of instructions to teach a friend how to do this. Remember to use the time conjunctions first, next, then, after that, finally.</p> <p>Real or nonsense?</p> <p>If you have a printer, print off the attached game. If not, a grown up could write out the words for you. Choose a coin and read the word. If it is real, put it in the treasure chest and if it is nonsense, put it in the bin.</p>
Maths	<p>Telling the time</p> <p>Using a paper plate (or draw around a plate on a piece of paper) make a clock with your child. Talk about the numbers that appear on the clock. Using two straws (or something similar) show your child how to make o clock and half past times on the clock.</p> <p>Listen to the story of the bad tempered lady bird. <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=CFMaEVfntnM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=CFMaEVfntnM</a></p> <p>Talk about what happens in the story and then use your clock to show some of the times the ladybird met the animals.</p>
Art	<p>Self portrait</p> <p>Using the video and drawing sheet attached, have a try at drawing a self-portrait. Can you get all of the features in the correct place? You might need a mirror to help. Choose your colours carefully to match what you can see in the mirror.</p>
