As well as the year group booklets, the following are suggestions for different activities for the children

English

Letter writing

Choose a friend or family member you would like to write a letter to. Decide what you would like to tell them about before you start writing. Remember to start your letter with 'To' or 'Dear' and write 'Love from' at the end so they know who the letter is from.

Keep an eye out for the post man as he will be delivering some special letters this week.

Maths

Fractions

You will need playdough for this activity. There is a recipe attached if you would like to make your own. Talk to the children about what 'half' means. 1 of 2 equal parts. Make a selection of shapes with the playdough. Can they be cut in half? Is there a different way to half the shape? Are there any shapes you cannot half?

You will need 20 objects for this activity. (pennies, stones, grapes etc) Work with your children to find half of a number by sharing out the objects into two groups. E.g. find half of 10. Count out 10 grapes and then share them into 2 groups. How many are in each group? Repeat this with other numbers to 20.

Science

Plant and flower hunt.

Take a walk around the local park and see how many plants and flowers you can find from the checklist. List any others you can see.



	Choose one flower and draw/paint/collage a picture of this. Talk with your grown up about the different parts of the flower and label these.
