English	<p><b>Poetry</b></p> <p><b>Activity 1</b> – Find a picture of the waves at the beach and label it by identifying all of the different things you can see. Then write some sentences using the words in your labels. See Google Classroom for the picture.</p> <p><b>Activity 2</b> – Look at the picture you used yesterday and this time write some adjectives (describing words) to describe what you can see. I would also like you to write what you could hear and smell at the beach too. See Google Classroom for resources.</p> <p><b>Activity 3</b> – Tomorrow you are going to write a poem all about the beach but first you need to plan it. Use the planning sheet I have put onto Google Classroom to help you plan your poem.</p> <p><b>Activity 4</b> – Write a poem using lots of describing words to describe the beach. Try to start each line with the same starter e.g. The calm waves.</p>

Geography	<p><b>What can you find in rock pools?</b></p> <p>You can choose one of these options to complete your geography work.</p> <p>Option 1 On your daily walk go to the beach and investigate what you can see in rock pools. You can take pictures to show me what you found.</p> <p>Option 2 Research the different things you could find in a rock pool and draw then for me. Make sure that you label them too.</p>
