English

This half term we have looked at three different books and the children have produced some wonderful writing. We created a non-chronological report based on arctic foxes; inspired by our arctic fox adoption at Christmas. We have also looked at the text 'Stuck' by Oliver Jeffers and produced our own mini-books written in the same style. Finally we have created some wonderful robot poetry based on the text; the wild robot. The children have worked incredibly hard and enjoyed the different text styles.

Maths

We started our spring term looking at telling the time. The children worked on telling the time to the nearest minute on digital, analogue and 24-hour clocks. They have worked very hard and have made good progress with this topic. We have also looked at fractions and the children have enjoyed many practical lessons looking at how fractions are made and how they can apply this to numbers.



Art

For art this half term the children have been exploring different ways to dye fabric. They have used tie-dye and batik to create some fantastic patterns. The children have also learned about different types of material and how material has been used to create works of art throughout history.
