English

We have focused on the text 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London' in our English lessons. Since this story is linked to our history topic, we investigated how we knew the settings and characters were historical. We used this information to write a settings description and a character profile. To help us add more detail into our writing we focused on adverbs. After investigating different adverbs, we realised that the adverbs we were working with all ended in 'ly'. Some of us used adverbs in the middle of our sentences to support a verb and others used adverbs to start sentences. This skill was then used to write our own historical story.

Next, we moved onto learning all about information texts. During this time, we looked at what an information text is and the features that should be used. We were able to use our knowledge of the Great Fire of London to write our own information text. The vocabulary, which we all used to support our knowledge, was excellent.

Maths

During our maths lessons, we learnt all about division. We were able to make links with other calculations when dividing which showed our teachers that we are making connections. Everyone had a go at dividing in two different ways but we preferred to use arrays, not repeated subtraction.
