

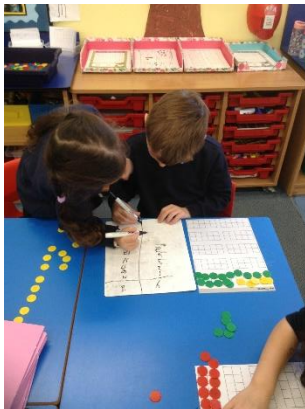
## Year One- Spring 1
