

Year 1 - spring 1

The children have been working with numbers up to 20 in maths. They have been ordering, finding one more and one less, using the greater than and less than symbols and practising different methods of adding these numbers.

In English, we have been rewriting the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. The children practised retelling the story with actions to help them remember the order of events. They have also been performing and writing their own poems!

The children loved making their own puppets in DT. They practised different joining techniques and designed what they would like their finished item to look like. They showed excellent scissor control when cutting their material!



In ICT, the children have been learning how to programme the 'beebots' to move. They investigated what happened when they pressed different buttons and then challenged their partner to move the robot to different places on the map.

have been listening to lots of stories from the Bible in RE and talking about how Jesus loved, cared for and healed people. They thought about how they could show care and kindness to others.

In PE this half term, the children have been focusing on gymnastics.



They have practised balancing on different parts of the body and investigating how to make shapes with their body. They have also been learning how to move around the apparatus safely while being creative, moving and jumping in different ways.
