After that, we used the story "Alfie's Star" to help us to understand the structure of a 4-part story. We acted out the story first, then we created our own versions, using time connectives to help our story flow. In maths, we have been doing lots of work on adding subtracting 2 digit numbers, using equipment to help us when numbers needed to be exchanged.





In March, we were visited by Mrs Chippendale from the Openzone, who taught us how to create simple programs using ScratchJr, focusing on sequencing and events which related to storytelling and literacy.
