

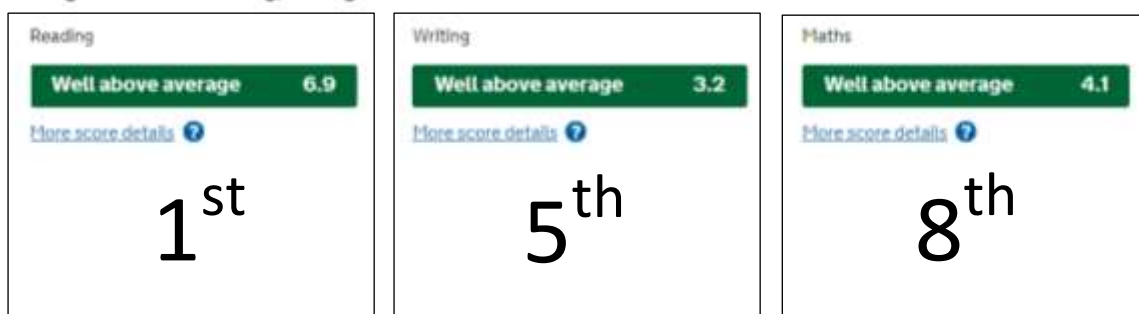


The primary league tables have just been released and we are proud to share with you how well St Anne's School achieved in 2018.
