Children at St Anne's make excellent progress in all subjects. By the end of Key Stage 1 children are achieving well above the national average in all subjects.

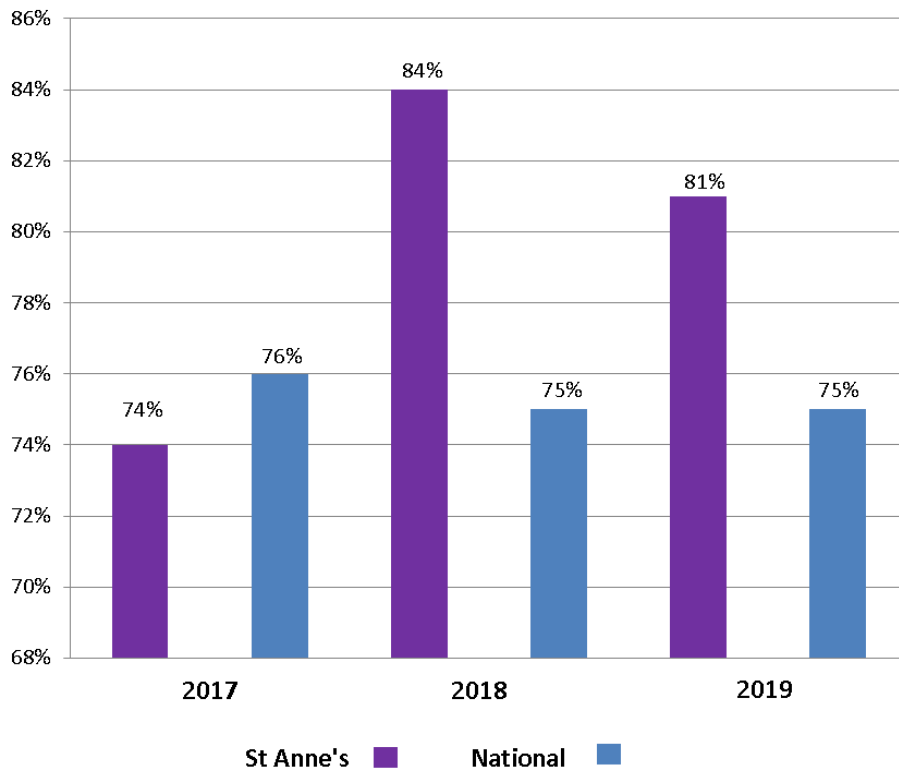
Many of our children exceeded the expected standard and are working at greater depth in all subjects.

All children at St Anne's school are well prepared to take on the challenge of the Key Stage 2 curriculum, both academically and socially and emotionally.

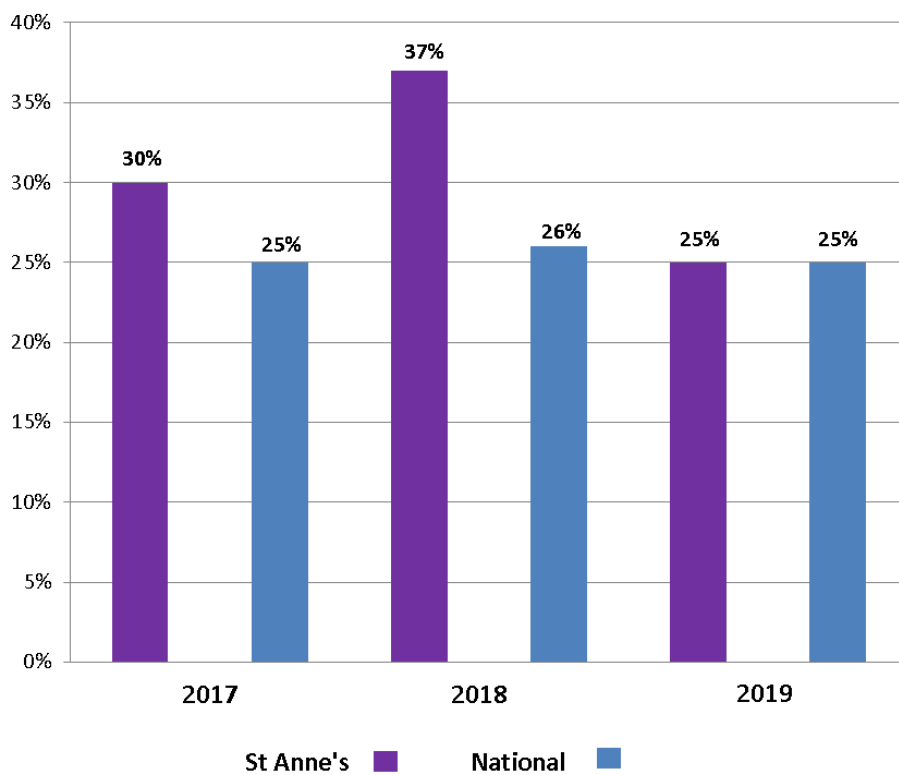
The charts below show how well children at St Anne's are achieving compared to other primary schools in the country.

KS1 Reading - All Pupils

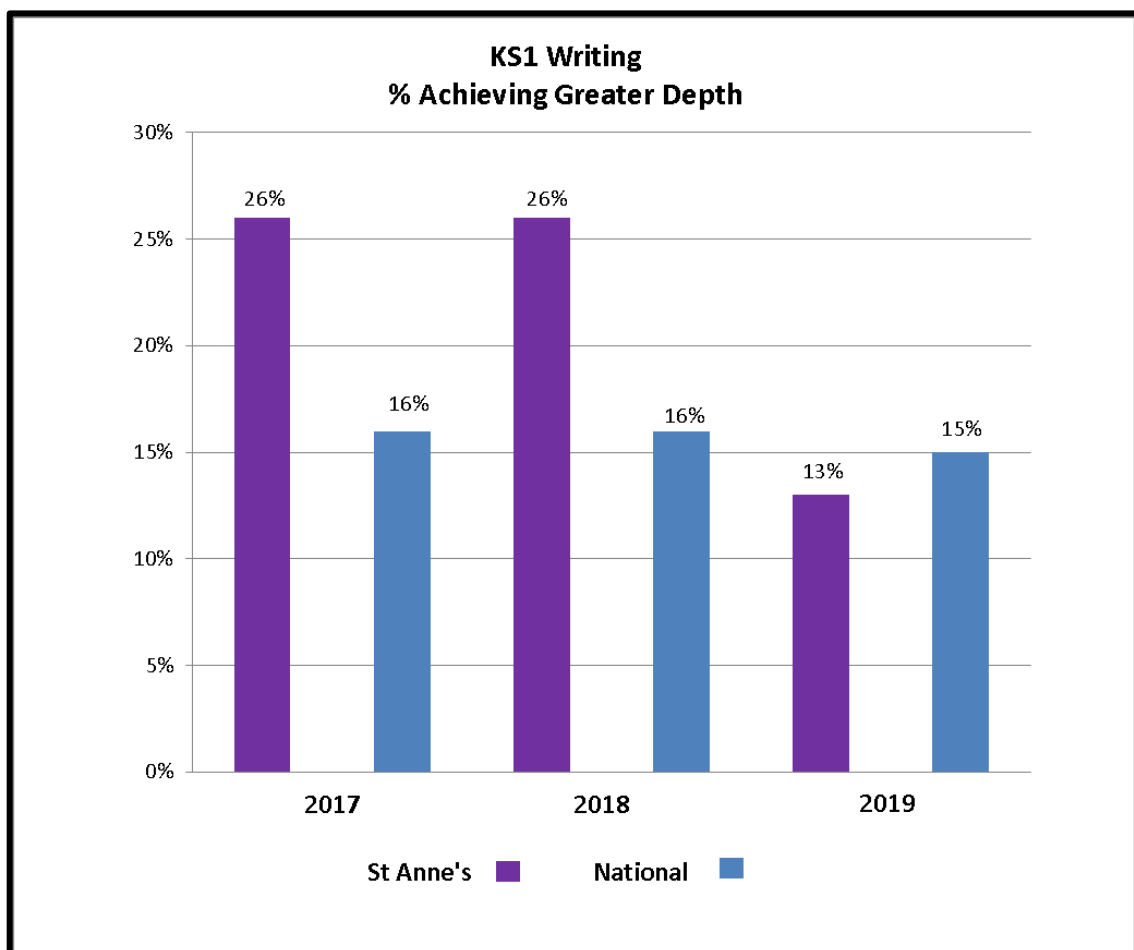
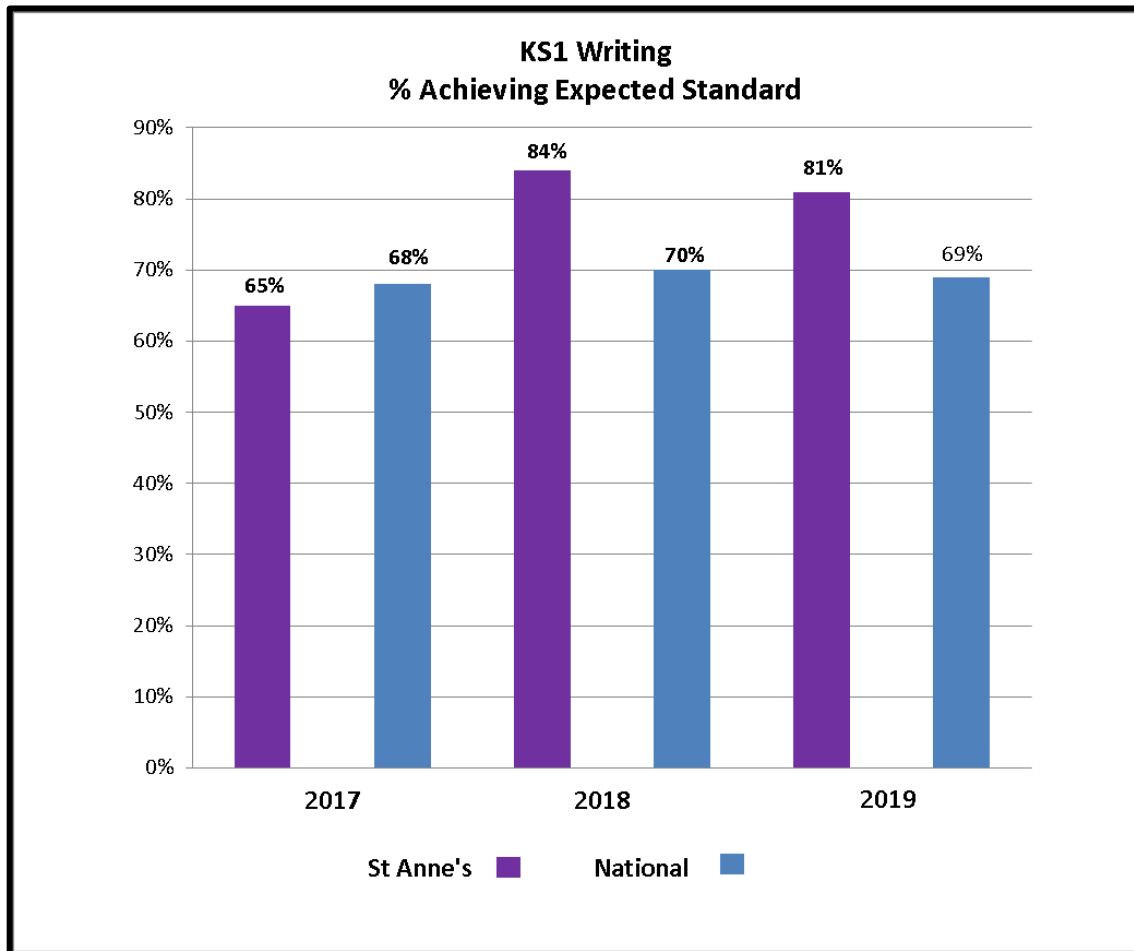
KS1 Reading % Achieving Expected Standard



KS1 Reading % Achieving Greater Depth

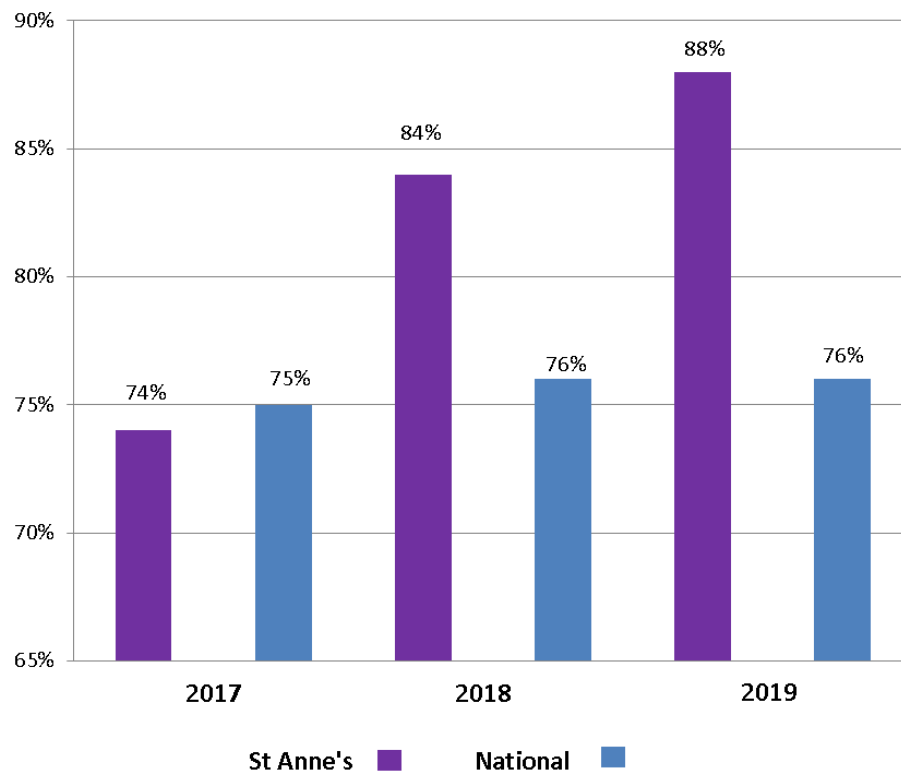


KS1 Writing- All Pupils
