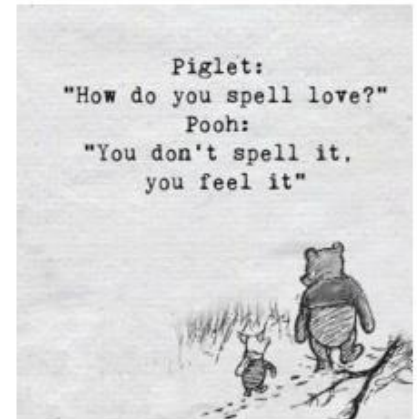

**Key message:**

Love is a verb! The Bible teaches that Jesus calls his people to love others through their actions and words, something which he demonstrated continuously throughout his life and teachings. Christians call this type of love Agape, a practical love that reflects the love God has for his people. 'We love, because God first loved us.' 1 John 4:19
