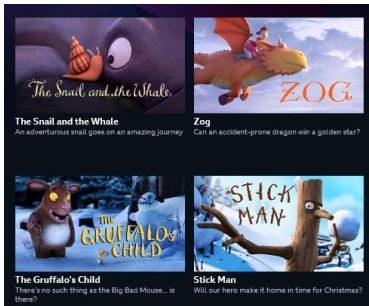
Summer Term Home Learning
