Most importantly it costs you nothing, other than 5 to 10 minutes of your time, and is really simple to sign up by following the guide below.


If you currently have an Amazon account this will work, it will not change anything about your subscriptions or existing account preferences.

Step 1 - Joining AmazonSmile to Donate


Please use your mobile device to do this entire process.

Open a new internet browser window and enter the following address or you can search for it



Check the checkbox and Press "Start Shopping"

Step 2 - Turning on Donations on all your purchases


To complete the process, you must now make a change in your Amazon app so that it records all your purchases through Amazon Smile.

*The screenshots may differ depending on your device, but the process is exactly the same.


Open your Amazon App

Select "Settings"




You should see an option called "AmazonSmile"


If you don't see this option skip to Troubleshooting


Next turn on AmazonSmile in your App

Troubleshooting

Oh dear, things haven't worked as Amazon intended. There are a few options you can try.

- Log out of your Amazon App, revisit http://smile.amazon.co.uk see if you can browse the products and it's your account. Then log back into your Amazon App and look in settings.
- Uninstall your Amazon App, restart your phone, revisit http://smile.amazon.co.uk see if you can browse the products and it's your account. Then reinstall the Amazon App and log back into your Amazon App and look in settings.
- If neither of these have worked, you can still shop via AmazonSmile by adding a shortcut to your home screen. Go to http://smile.amazon.co.uk and find the options on your browser (this will be different on every phone so wording may differ). Press Add to Home Screen You will have to click on this icon rather than your Amazon App (they are identical, just a different way to access)
