English

- Reading: Individual, group and shared. Reading for pleasure and information through library work, stories and group work. A variety of fiction and non-fiction stories and poems with familiar settings. Development of comprehension skills: vocabulary, retrieval, inference, predicting, sequencing
- **Spelling:** Learning of high frequency words as sight vocabulary. Read Write Ink Phonics Programme
