### **Book Fair: 18th - 24th November**



### Fair Processing Notice' has been replaced by 'Privacy Notice'

Schools, Local Authorities (LA), the Department for Education (DfE) and other educational bodies that process personal data about pupils and staff are required by the Data Protection Act (1998) to issue a Notice to parents/pupils and staff to inform them of the purposes for which that personal data may be held and used. The Information Commissioner has recommended that the term 'Fair Processing Notice' is to be replaced by 'Privacy Notice'. The aim is to make the Privacy Notices general and constant. Any changes to the details of organisations with which school or LA data is shared can be updated on the LA and DfE websites. The new approach means that a single, short and easily understandable Privacy Notice is now published on our website; look in the Data Protection pages of the Information section.
