Nursery Places 2015 - Apply at the school office

Will your child be 3 years old in September? If so you need to apply for your place in our Nursery class. Nursery applications are made directly to the school, and NOT via the Local Authority.

Flexible Nursery Entitlement (15 hours)

Nursery is considered to be a vital part of our Early Years provision. Woodcroft Nursery has a maximum capacity of 52 places. Pupils are entitled to 15 hours free provision per week. Parents are consulted and we endeavour to match the needs of the family with an appropriate offer of provision. This can be through a variety of flexible arrangements, such as:

- Five 3 hour sessions per week
- Three five hour sessions per week
- Four 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hour sessions and one full day

Additional 'charged' Sessions

In addition to a child's 15 hours of free entitlement, Woodcroft Nursery is able to provide extra 3 hour sessions of Nursery care at a rate of £16.50.
