CURRICULUM INFORMATION ON OUR TOPIC

WHAT COMES FIRST?!

The areas of the curriculum to be covered this term will be:

Literacy: Author studies, shape poetry and instructional writing.

Maths: reviewing addition, subtraction and multiplication. We will also be learning about division, fractions, rounding numbers and handling data. Throughout the units we will be looking at word problems and solving puzzles. Remember to learn all of your timestables up to 12x12.

Science: Animals and Life Cycles. We will also be developing your children's science investigational skills.

ICT: We have an exciting new ICT curriculum. Our topics will be: We Are Communicators and We Are Pollsters.

P.E: Each class will be taken for one session each week by a specialist coach for Games. They will also be taking part in Gymnastics and will be taught a Flamenco Dance by a specialist dance teacher.

Art: Paintings by Rousseau.

DT: Research, design, create and evaluate a healthy dish.

R.E: Looking at Islam and the individual.

PHSC&E: Our SEAL units this term our 'Going for Goals' and 'Good To Be Me'. We will also be working on the Be The Best You Can Be project.

Spanish: Classroom instructions, counting to 20 and name and age.

Music: The children will also be learning how to play the ukulele for one session a week.
