Prestigious Award for Woodcroft

Woodcroft has been awarded the Quality Mark for Physical Education & Sport.

Following a review of Woodcroft's PE provision by an assessment panel, that included an inspection visit by an afPE validator, we were awarded the Quality Mark for 'demonstrating good commitment

improvement in physical education & sport'. Only 18 schools nationally received this award during the winter assessment period. The award is valid for three years, commencing February 2015. Changes to Assessment and Reporting at Woodcroft The End of Assessment Levels for Key Stage 1 and 2 (Y1 to Y6)

The way that schools assess pupils in Years 1 to 6 is changing. The Government has decided to end National Curriculum Assessment Levels but has not replaced them with another system. Each school is being asked to develop their own arrangements, although we still have to track progress and report it to parents.

Please note: Y2 and Y6 will continue to be measured using the 'old' system of levels for this academic year.

New Pupil Reports and Target Reviews

We will NOT be providing a mid-year report as normal this year as we update our arrangements. We will however be providing a 'Mid Year Progress Review' for each pupil. This will provided at the Parent Consultation Meetings next week on Tuesday 3rd (4-7pm) and Wednesday 4th (4-6pm). These parent consultation meetings will give you an opportunity to discuss your child's progress so far this year and review their targets. These targets will have been shared with pupils. It will also provide information on attendance and attitudes to learning. We strongly encourage all parents to make an appointment with their class teachers and attend this valuable Parent Consultation Meeting. A full annual report of progress will now be provided at the end of the academic year, further details will follow in the Summer term.

We hope this new system will provide parents with clearer feedback on their child's progress and targets for improvement.
