### **CURRICULUM INFORMATION ON OUR TOPIC**

## 'The Groovy Greeks'

### The areas of the curriculum to be covered this term will be:

**Literacy:** Myths and legends, dialogue and playscripts, narratives with familiar settings and poems to perform.

**Maths:** Symmetry, direction and position, reading scales, looking at different measurements, time and shape. Throughout the units we will be looking at word problems and solving puzzles. Remember to learn all of your timestables up to 12x12.

**Science:** Plants and magnets and friction. We will also be developing your children's science investigational skills.

ICT: 'We Are Communicators' and 'We Are Network Engineers'

**P.E:** Each class will be taken for one session each week by a specialist games coach. The children will also have half a term of outdoor adventurous activities and a dance unit taught by the class teacher.

Art: Clay pottery.

**DT:** Research, design and make a Greek theatre mask.

**R.E:** Looking at different places of worship.

**PHSC&E:** Our SEAL units this term are 'Relationships' and 'Changes'. We will also be continuing with work on our 'Be The Best You Can Be' project and SRE.

**Spanish:** Days of the week, months of the year and time expressions.

**Music:** The children will continue learning to play the ukulele for one session a week.
