Our Work This Term

Our theme this term is called **Animal adaptations!**

The areas of the curriculum to be covered this term will be:

Literacy: stories from other cultures, persuasive texts, recount and poetry

Numeracy: multiplication, division, fractions and measures (including time)

Science: Classification, groups and different environments. Animal food chains and digestive systems.

ICT: Creating an interactive toy and html editors

PE: **Swimming all year every Tuesday afternoon.** Each class will be taken for one session each week by a specialist games coach for one half term and by Mr Judd for Gymnastics for one half term too.

Geography: Animal Adaptations to different environments

Art: Animal Pencil Sketches.

RE: Studying different religious books.
