# Year 5 Summer Term 2015



Welcome back to Woodcroft Primary School. This newsletter aims to give you information about the areas of the curriculum that Year 5 will be covering this Summer Term . Our Topic is ONE STEP BEYOND! (Earth and Space).

**Maths:** This term we will be studying fractions, percentages and decimals, estimating and measuring volume and capacity, and calculating the area of different shapes.. We will also be looking at negative numbers, rounding numbers and converting between units of time. As well as this, we will be identifying multiples and factors, drawing angles, and solving word problems involving measures, addition and subtraction, and multiplication and division.

**Literacy:** The children will be studying a wide range of books and writing styles this term. Areas of study will include persuasive and discussion writing, performance poetry, instructions, narrative through a book study, and explanation. Information technology will also be used to develop literacy skills. Homework will continue to be set for spellings and reading.

#### SCIENCE :

This term our Science topic is Earth and Space. Within this unit we will be looking at stars, planets, space and space travel.

#### **COMPUTING:**

The two Computing topics are 'We Are Architects' and 'We Are Bloggers'. In the first unit, we will be using 3D modelling programs to create our own buildings. In the second, the children will be blogging about space and what they are learning about in our Topic lessons.

<u>Geography</u>: The children will be spending time looking at maps and atlases. We will be looking at the geographical features of countries on the Equator, and in the Tropics and the Arctic regions of Earth.

Sports activities will be taught by Mr Raw on Thursdays.

Pupils will also take part in Outdoor Adventurous Activities, supported by Mr Judd.

Our Dance unit, meanwhile, will be supported by Miss Williams.
