## - How soon can I apply?

$\square$ the application process begins on 1 September 2015

■ Where do I apply?

$\square$ apply online at www.eadmissions.org.uk

## How do I apply?

- How many schools can I apply for?
$\square$ you can apply for up to SiX schools
$\square$ you will rank the schools in your order of preference
$\square$ it is important to think carefully about the order as you will not be able to change it after the closing date
- Can I apply to schools outside Barnet?
$\square$ yes, you must include all your chosen schools, whether inside or outside the borough where you live


## How do I apply?

- Do I need to fill in any other forms?
$\square$ all voluntary aided schools and some foundation schools, free schools \& academies will ask you to complete a Supplementary Information Form (SIF)
$\square$ the SIF will ask for additional information, for example
- faith schools will ask about church attendance and require a priest's reference
- selective schools will ask about any medical condition that needs to be taken into account at the test and they may also require a photograph
$\square$ Jewish schools will also ask you to complete a a Certificate of Religious Practice (CRP), which must be signed by a Rabbi
$\square$ SIFs and CRPs must be returned to the individual schools


## How do I apply?

■ What else do I need to provide?
$\square$ Proof of address

- your permanent address must be used on the application form
- if you have moved in the last two years you will be asked to provide proof of the new address and proof that you have disposed of the previous address


## Selection Tests

■ Schools must give parents the test results before they apply for a school place
$\square$ applications to sit the tests should be made directly to the individual school

## Selection Tests.

## - When will the tests be held?

$\square$ For some schools the tests start in the summer term while your child is still in Year 5!
$\square$ This includes Mill Hill County

## How do I apply?

- When is the closing date for application form?
$\square 31$ October 2015
$\square$ the online system will close at 12 midnight on 31 October


## What happens next?

- Co-ordinated admissions
$\square$ the transfer process is co-ordinated by all 33 London boroughs
$\square$ application lists are exchanged
$\square$ offer lists are drawn up
$\square$ offer lists are exchanged


## What happens next?

- How will places be allocated?
$\square$ if the school is over-subscribed, the admissions criteria will be applied to decide who can be offered a place
$\square$ each application is considered as if it is equally preferred
$\square$ your ranking order is not passed to the individual schools


## Offers

- Will I be offered more than one school place?
$\square$ if your child can be offered more than one school, you will be offered the highest rank possible
$\square$ the lower preferences will be withdrawn and offered to other children
$\square$ no child will be offered more than one school


## Offers

- When will I hear?
$\square$ National Offer Day is Tuesday 1 March 2016
$\square$ online applicants can log in and see the result in the evening of 1 March
$\square$ letters will be sent on 1 March to applicants who are not offered their first preference explaining what to do next


## Offers

- Accepting offers
$\square$ places to be accepted by 15 March 2016
$\square$ online applicants can accept or reject their offer online
$\square$ other applicants need to return the reply slip


## No Offer?

■ What happens if I don't get any of my preference schools?
$\square$ your child will be allocated a place at the nearest school with a vacancy
$\square$ remain on the waiting lists
$\square$ appeal for a place
$\square$ join waiting lists for other schools

## Appeals

- Every parent has the right of appeal
- Appeals are heard by an independent panel
- You will have the opportunity to present your case in person
- You will need to convince the panel that your child's needs are more important than the school's need to limit the admission number
- Appeals are not usually successful unless there are exceptional grounds
