#### **New Earth Loom and Bench for the Butterfly Garden**

An exciting addition to the Butterfly Garden is scheduled to be installed next week!

Earth looms are fixed wooden structures that are strung to create a loom.



Weaving is then carried out using traditional fibres like wool, cloth and string as well as sticks, grasses and reeds that might be found. Children of all ages and abilities love to weave. The collaborative nature of such an installation is important. The looms are a fantastic way to encourage the creative arts in school and bring the artistic and natural worlds together.
