Annual Reports Published on Monday 13th

Pupils annual reports will be published on Monday 13th July. These can only be given to an adult, so please arrange for someone to collect your copy if you are unable to attend school on Monday.

New Report Format: This year's reports will be very different to previous ones. The government changed the way pupils are to be assessed and asked schools to report progress in line with new national expectations for year groups. As a result, your will find you child is recorded as either emerging (working below), expected (working within) or exceeding (working above) these new criteria. There will also be a record of attitude to learning and behaviour in school, including homework. Teachers have also written a brief progress statement to outline any key areas and progress toward targets.

We hope that you find the new reports clear and concise. We also hope that they help you gain a good understanding of your child's strengths. Please note that schools nationally have found the criteria very challenging and as a result there are more children categorised as emerging and expected across the country. This is part of a national strategy by the government to challenge schools to raise standards. If you would like to discuss the report, teachers will be available in their classrooms on Tuesday 14th July from 4.00pm to 6.30pm. There will not be any set appointments, and parents will be seen on a first come first served basis. Please bring your report along on the evening. Mrs Cullen will also be on hand in the KS2 foyer to discuss any SEN concerns that parents may have.
