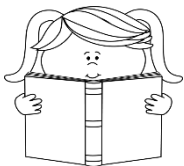
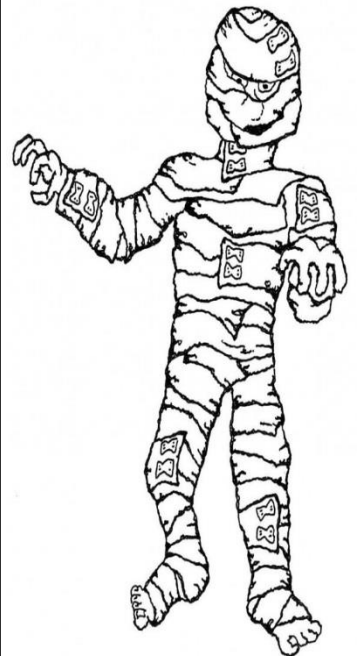

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Literacy: Basic literacy skills (VCOP), Adventure stories. Report writing, Instructions and Stories with a familiar setting. We will also be looking at reading, spelling, grammar and handwriting.

Maths: Place value, number pairs, number, addition, subtraction, doubling and halving, multiplication and division. We will also be looking at problem solving using the 4 operations.

Science: Rock and Soils and Light. We will also be developing your children's science investigational skills.

Computing: We have an exciting new computing curriculum. Our topics will be: We are Programmers and We are bug Fixers

P.E: Dance with a choreographer and gymnastics with Mr. Judd. Each class will be taken for one session each week by a specialist games coach.

Art: Planning and creating an Egyptian wall mural piece of art.

DT: Researching, designing and creating a 3D pyramid.

History: Ancient Egyptians and their achievements, such as hieroglyphics and the pyramids

Geography: The Water Cycle and Weather

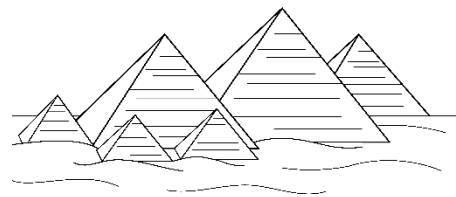
R.E: Inspirational people.
