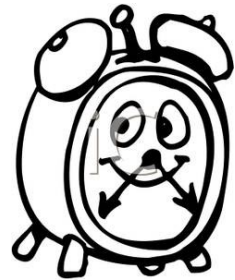

Our Work This Term

Our theme this term is The Roman Empire!



The areas of the curriculum to be covered in this term will be:

Literacy: Stories with historical settings, explanation texts, creating images through poetry, and stories which raise issues and dilemmas. We will also be focussing on hand-writing and guided reading takes place every day.

Numeracy: All four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) within number, 2D shape, measuring, fractions, time and data handling.

Science: We will be studying the unit Electricity and Sound. We will also continue to develop your child's science investigative skills.

Computing: The children will be producing a wiki page and using computers to produce music linked to our Roman topic.

PE: Swimming all year, every Tuesday afternoon! We will also be doing gymnastics and dance this term.

Art: We will design and make our own mosaics and shields.

DT: Researching, designing and creating torches.

History: We will be learning about the Roman Empire.

RE: Values and making choices.

PHSE: Our units are New Beginnings, Good to be Me and Anti-bullying Week. We will also cover units of work on road safety with the 'Safer Moves' project.

Spanish: Counting to 40 and fruit.
