Woodcroft Netball and Football Teams continued their excellent seasons this week:

#### **Woodcroft Achieve Tottenham Foundation Silver Medals**



Following our success in the Barnet heats, the football team travelled to Tottenham Hotspur's prestigious First Team Training Ground in Enfield on Friday 5th February to compete against the best teams from across North London, and the chance to play in the National Schools Cup. The standard of play was extremely high, and all the matches were close affairs. Woodcroft won their pool in the group stages, and then their semi-final, only to lose to a single goal in a close final against Chingford School 0-1. The team came away with silver medals proud of their achievements, and

each boy was presented with two tickets to see Tottenham play at Whitehart Lane against Italian club Fiorentina in the Europa Cup on 24th February.
