

Holidays in School Time

Parents are reminded that rules on holidays in term-time are still in force and the law has not changed. Barnet's Education Welfare Team will continue to issue fixed-penalty notices (FPNs) to parents who take children out of school without authorised leave. Holidays will not be authorised. Leave requests must be made in advance and will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. The recent high profile coverage about term time holidays in the news may create a misleading picture. Parents can best support their children and the school by abiding by the rules. Head teachers are required to apply the rules firmly and fairly and are held to account by the Government. It is therefore expected that parents act responsibly and plan holidays and family visits when school is closed.

Passport Applications

Can I remind parents that it is school policy **NOT** to sign passports after the ½ term break. In the vast majority of cases the school is contacted by The Passport Office after applications are submitted in order to provide additional identity checks. To ensure that this does not occur after school closes for the summer break we are not able to process applications from June onwards. If you are planning to renew your passport please ensure that you do so before we break up on Friday 27th May. Please do not ask afterwards as school staff will politely decline.

Ditch Your Stabilisers 'again' on Tuesday 24th May

Cycling expert, Arthur Shearlaw, from Sustrans, will be joining us after school on Tuesday 24th May for another session of 'Ditch Your Stabilisers'. Every pupil that attended the first session this week all learnt to ride their bikes without stabilisers! If you are in Y1, Y2, Y3 or Y4 and want to learn to ride your bike make sure you come along on Tuesday after school. Bikes can be brought to school in the morning and left securely during the day. Alternatively, parents can bring them at 3.15pm ready for the session.
