Lenny's Leap of Faith - Fun Day on 12th November



A group of parents are organising a Family Fun Day to be held at Woodcroft on Saturday 12th November in support of 'Lenny's Leap of Faith' campaign.

Lenny, the son of our Reception Class member of staff
Nina Kearns, was born 6 weeks early after a traumatic
start to life. Then a brain scan and tests showed that
Lenny had not been getting oxygen during birth. He was
diagnosed with cerebral palsy and now requires a frame

and medication to enable him to walk. Unfortunately, the operation needed to enable him to walk has been removed from the NHS. Lenny's family have begun a fundraising campaign to raise the £30,000 required to pay for the operation and therapeutic physio.

Though not an official school event, a fun day will be run by a group of parents and hosted at Woodcroft from 1.00pm on Saturday 12th November. Please make a note in your diary and come along to help this worthy cause.

Application for Reception Class in September 2017

Children who were born between 1st September 2012 & 31st August 2013 should now be aware that the application process is now open for entry into primary Reception in September 2017. A leaflet and guide was sent home to all Nursery parents that explained the online admissions system. Please be aware that **ALL** parents **MUST** re-apply for their child's place. Being on role in Woodcroft's Nursery does not guarantee you a place in Reception. More information can be found on our website. There will also be a parent information meeting on Friday 11th November at 9.00am and again at 12.45pm for parents to attend after they have dropped their child in at Nursery. Please make your way across the playground through the blue doors to our 4D TARDIS suite.
