New Boiler Room Project

Major works are due to start at Woodcroft over the Christmas period and will



continue up to February half term. We are scheduled to have our ageing boilers replaced. As you can imagine, the size of boiler needed to heat the whole school is somewhat larger than the domestic variety we have at home - in fact we need three giant boilers and they fill an entire room!The project is costing around £170.000 and will last for 8 weeks. In the meantime we will be having a temporary boiler sited along the front pathway adjacent to the hall. This

section of path will be fenced off for the duration of the project. Scaffolding will also be erected to access the chimney flues. We have been assured that work will not disrupt the regular running of the school. However, if you have any concerns during this period please let the school know.
