### **Our Work This Term**

Our theme this term is called Animal adaptations!

The areas of the curriculum to be covered in this term will be:

**English:** Explanation texts, stories from other cultures, persuasive texts, recount and poetry.

**Maths:** Measure (including time), shape, statistics, the four operations  $(+ - x \div)$ , fractions and word problems.

**Science:** Classification, groups and different environments (habitats). Animal food chains and digestive systems.
