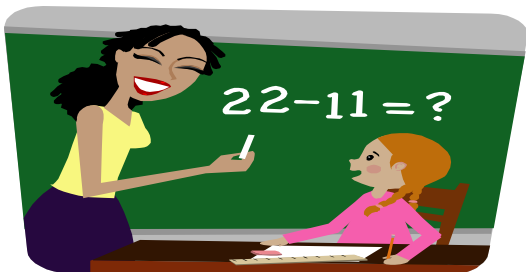
English and Maths
