"I really liked it when Captain Grimey had a bath because it made a big SPLASH!" Mohammed, 1C.

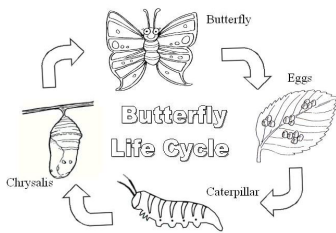
"I also liked it when Captain Grimey was riding his boat and there was a scary creature!" Renee, 1C.
