Wreaths are laid at the Cenotaph and memorials held around the country on Remembrance Sunday, which falls this Sunday, on 12 November 2017. It is a day for the nation to remember and honour

those who have sacrificed themselves to secure and protect our freedom. A Two Minute Silence is held each year at the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month to mark the end of the First World War. We had a silent reflection in school assembly today, Friday 10th.

Poppies, available in school, are a symbol of Remembrance, inspired by John McCrae's poem - 'In Flanders Fields'.
