## **Extreme Weather and School Closures**



Thank you for your patience and understanding during the period of snow and ice last week. At Woodcroft we aim to stay open as much as possible as we know that every day counts in a child's education.

When making a decision to close, we consider the following:

- Safety of the school site
- Conditions on surrounding roads and paths for pupils and parents
- Risk of travel and ability of staff to get safely to and from work
- Weather forecasts and alerts
- Giving parents sufficient notice to make arrangements.

During the week conditions were always safe on site thanks to the hard work of our staff to ensure paths were cleared and gritted. The weather was very unpredictable with yellow and amber warnings, and parents expressed concern about roads and pavements. However, by staggering the start and finish times of school we felt that this risk was manageable.

On Friday morning, at 6.00am, the MET Office forecast a 60% - 70% likelihood of more snow all day! Because of this, and the continued freezing temperatures, it was decided that it would unsafe to open the school. We realise that everyone has different views, and in reality, the snow didn't arrive until much later in the afternoon, but we hope you understood the reasons behind the decision to close.
