Good Luck to our Woodcroft Dance Team. They are competing in the national primary school 'Dance Off' finals on Monday in Oxford!

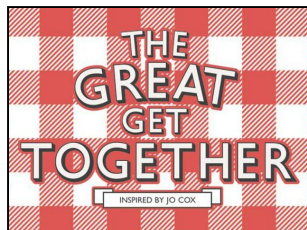
Measles Warning from Director of Public Health

Join Woodcroft at The 'Burnt Oak' Great Get Together From 2.45pm, Saturday 23rd June at St Alphage Church Hall



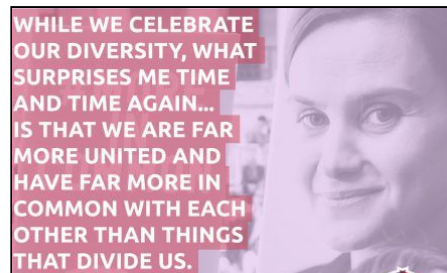

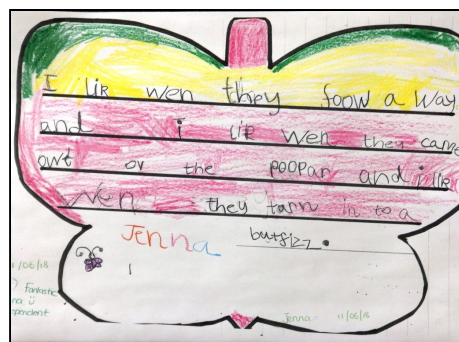
Foundation Stage Butterflies

The children in our Reception and Nursery classes got the chance to release their Painted Lady Butterflies last week. Here are reports written by two pupils from the Reception.

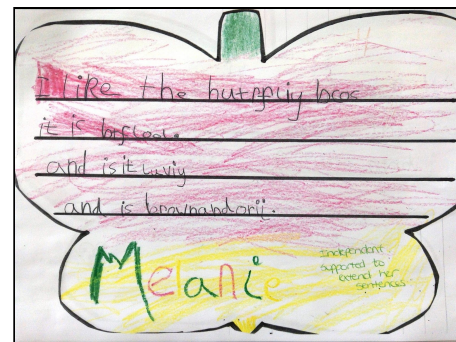

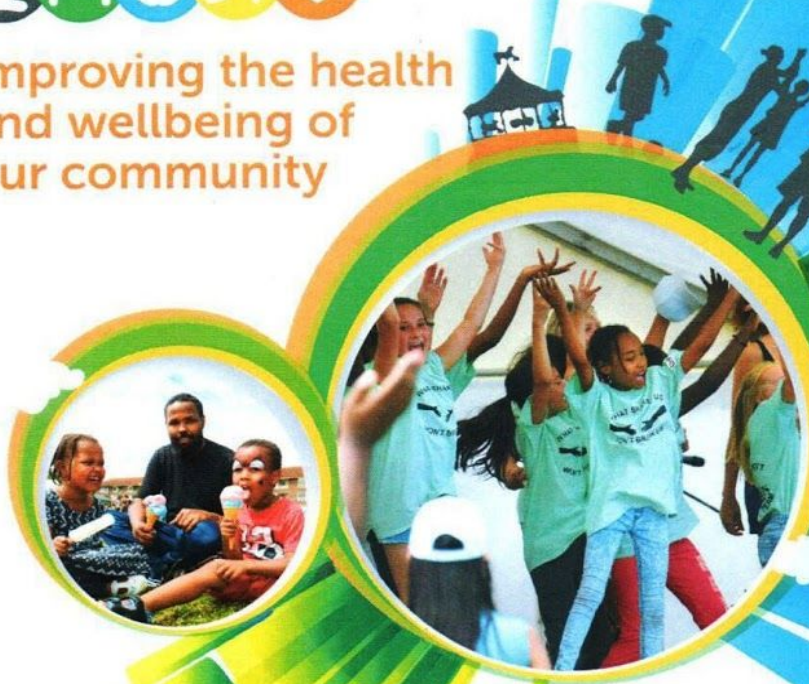
