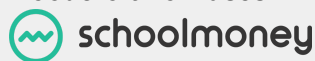

Thank you to everyone who came along and supported our mini-summer fayre last week! We raised £400!

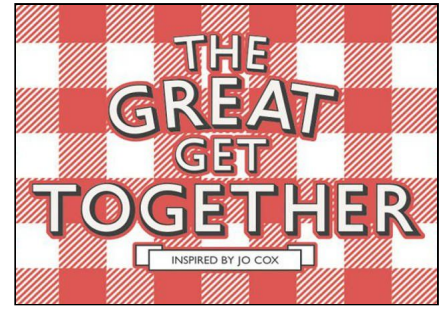

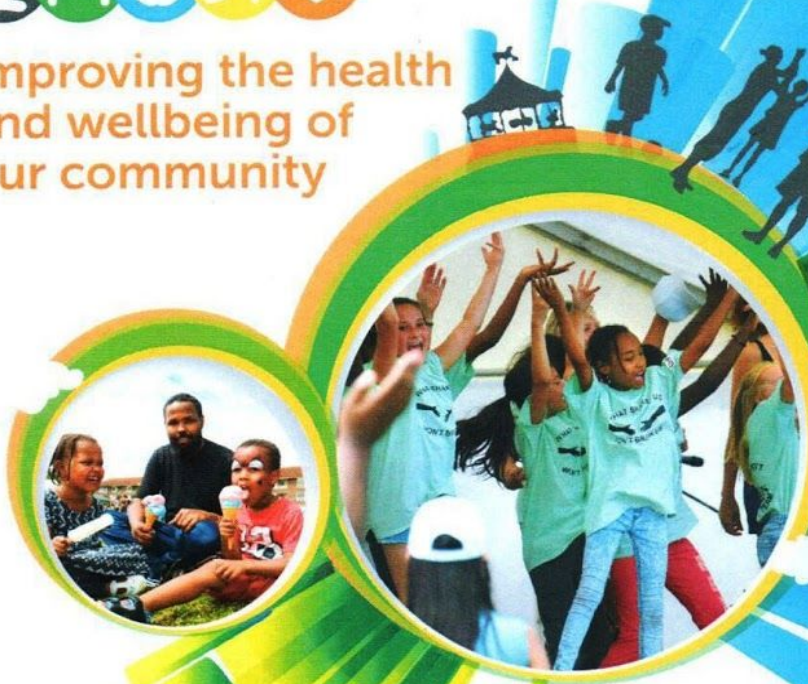
