Fantastic Results Achieved Throughout The School!

Best ever scores for Reception in the Early Years Profile

The results for our current Reception pupils are the highest ever achieved for Woodcroft, with **68% achieving the crucial GLD score!** This is an increase on the previous year of 5%!

(Good Level Of Development (GLD) is achieved by reaching the expected standards in all prime areas and also the specific areas of literacy and mathematics)

Stunning Year 1 Phonics Outcomes

An amazing **95**% of our Year 1 pupils passed the phonics test. This equals our best ever score!

Big increases in Year 2 KS1 SATs results

We had a fantastic set of KS1 SATs results with stellar improvements in every area! **Reading improved by 23%** to reach an amazing 83%. **Writing imped by 14%** to a high of 66%. And maths leaped by 16% up to 73%!

Outstanding Year 6 SATs scores!

Year 6 made some phenomenal improvements in the important subjects of reading and Maths achieving our best ever set of results under the new system! Reading improved by a wonderful +21% with 70% making the grade. Mathematics also saw a big jump of 15% to reach 76%. With Writing at 74%, Grammar, punctuation and spelling scoring 72% and Science maintaining 76% pass this was a fantastic year for Year 6!
