Secondary Transfer Information for Y6 Families



Safeguarding Consultation For Site Security

Possible Risks

At Woodcroft we take pupil safety very seriously. Following an audit of site security we are proposing to implement a number of changes to the way people can access the site at the beginning and end of the school day. Woodcroft has multiple entrances at both the front and back of the school. We were concerned about the potential opportunities for people to access school premises, or pupils to leave, undetected. While the proposed changes might be initially inconvenient, they have been designed in best interests and safety of the children.

Consultation

Parents are being notified of the changes this week. Any comment should be made to the Headteacher, in writing, by Thursday 27th September. The agreed changes will then begin on **Monday 1st October**.

The start of the school day:

- The back entrance will <u>NOT</u> be opened until <u>8.30am</u> (previously 8.00am)
- All Breakfast Club pupils must arrive via front Main Entrance at 8.00am.
- o Only Breakfast Club children will be allowed into the school building at 8.00am
- No other children or parents will be allowed into the school building until 8.30am
- 8.00am Access via the Main Front Entrance for Breakfast Club only
- 8.30 Access to the site via Main Front Entrance and Back Entrance (but not the top KS2 / Y6 Door).
- 8.45 Top KS2 (Y6) Front Door opens for access
- 8.45 Foundation Stage opens for access
- 8.55 Bell rings and all doors and gates are locked. Access via buzzer at Main Front Entrance only

The end of the school day:

- 3.15 Front and back entrances open for access
- 3.30 All entrances locked Access via buzzer at Main Front Entrance only.
- 4.15 Main Front Entrance open for collection from clubs (No access via any other entrance)
- 4.30 All doors locked (School Closed)

If any club or activity is advertised to finish after 4.15pm the club leader will supervise dismissal from the main front entrance as appropriate.

Additional Nursery Access via Foundation Stage Entrance:

- 11.45 Foundation Stage is open for Morning Nursery Collection
- 12.15 Foundation Stage is open for Afternoon Nursery Arrival

Collection from Acorns Club is from the Oak Suite Entrance only
