The Year 4 Team would like to welcome you back after a relaxing festive break. This term is going to be another busy one with a great deal to get through before the summer term!



Our Work This Term

Our theme this term is Anglo Saxons and Settlements!



The areas of the curriculum to be covered in this term will be:

English: Plays, information texts, recounts, stories with imaginary settings. We will also be focussing on handwriting and guided reading takes place every day.

Maths: Fractions, telling the time and money. We will continue to work on times table knowledge and mental arithmetic on a weekly basis.

Science: Humans and other animals will be our focus for Science this term. This will include teeth, digestion and animal habitats. We will also continue to develop your child's science investigative skills.



ICT: We are software developers. This will involve coding and programming.

PE: Swimming every Tuesday afternoon. Each class will be taken for one session each week by a specialist games coach for half a term.



Art and Design technology: Researching, designing and creating clay Anglo Saxon style product.

History: We will learn about life in Britain after the Roman's left! This will focus on the settlements of the Anglo Saxons.

Geography: We will learn about settlements, rivers and local geography.
