This newsletter will give you information about the areas of the curriculum that Year 5 will be covering this Spring

MATHS: This term, we will be focusing on formal methods for multiplication and division. Later on in the term, we will be learning the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. The pupils will find fractions of amounts, read and write fractions from decimals and percentages, add, subtract and multiply fractions, and find equivalent fractions.

English: We are starting 2019 with an in-depth book study ('The Butterfly Lion' and 'You're A Bad Man Mr Gum!'). In line with our new History topic, we will also take a look at Viking myths and legends, including the story of the Norse God Odin. Additionally we will be reading, writing and performing poetry. We are also excited to announce that we have organised a trip to the Unicorn theatre in March to see 'Icarus'.

SCIENCE:

This term, we will be looking at Forces and We will be using Google Draw to we will learn about concepts such as gravity, water and air resistance and friction.

COMPUTING:
