


# **Welcome back to Woodcroft Primary School!**

# The Year 5 Autumn Curriculum

Maths Maths

This term, Year 5 will be following a scheme of learning called White Rose Maths. This scheme emphasises having a mastery of key concepts and operations, with an emphasis on reasoning, language and visual representation. In all blocks, the children apply their knowledge to problem solving and real life contexts. It is also an expectation that children in Year 5 know all of their times tables up to 12x12; Times Table Rock Stars will be used again this year. As well as this, the children will have regular arithmetic tests, where they will apply the skills they have learnt each week.





## **English**

This term, the children will be exploring both fiction and non-fiction texts. We will be studying Anne Fine as a significant children's author. We will also be looking at persuasive texts and performance poetry. Later on in the term, we will be studying stories from other cultures and South American myths.

#### SCIENCE

In Science, we will study animal and plant reproduction, life cycles and human growth. Children will look at materials and their properties. We will also continue with the successful 'Big Question' investigations related to each topic.





### **COMPUTING**

We will be learning how to code using a coding app. Additionally, look out for the children's Wiki pages on the Treehouse.

### **HISTORY**

In History, we will be looking at the Tudor Period, focusing on the kings and queens of the era, and the age of exploration. Links will be made to the Ancient Mayan civilisation. Children will also learn how to do historical research using Chromebooks.





#### **GEOGRAPHY**

To celebrate the arrival of our international guests from the BeHave project, we will be researching facts and information about Belgium, Italy, Portugal and Romania!

#### **SPANISH**

This term, the children will be continuing their course on the Duo Lingo app, with an emphasis on putting their new vocabulary into spoken sentences.





### **DESIGN TECHNOLOGY**

The children will develop their woodwork skills this term in order to design and create their own Tudor home.


## ART
