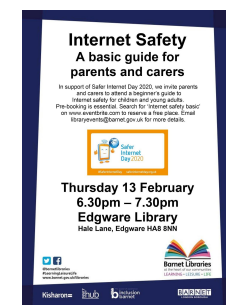
Woodcroft staff are involved in the development of software to support teachers across Europe.

Barnet Libraries is running a session on 'Internet Safety' for parents and carers. This is to promote Safer Internet Day which takes place next week. The event is taking place at Edgware Library, Hale Lane, Edgware HA8 8NN on Thursday 13 February from 6.30pm – 7.30pm.

This is an event for parents and carers only and is primarily an information session to signpost them to the best advice and support for keeping their children safe online. They will take away a parent's pack at the end of the session.



The hour long presentation is a 'beginner's' guide; ideally, but not exclusively, aimed at parents and carers of young people in years 5 to 8.
