Face Masks, Face Coverings and Social Distancing



Thank you to all of our school community for helping keep everyone safe by supporting the wearing of masks and keeping socially distant. During Lockdown all staff in school are wearing masks throughout the day when outside of their bubbles in corridors and communal areas. Did you know, at arrival and dismissal time we have close

to 1000 people on the school premises. That's a lot of potential close contact! While we realise this is mostly outside, we cannot guarantee social distancing.

We know that some individuals are exempt from wearing face coverings and we expect all staff, other adults and pupils to be sensitive to those needs. So while we may ask, 'are you able to wear a mask?' we understand if you cannot.

Updated COVID19 DfE Guidance For Schools

For this second national lockdown, The Department for Education updated the guidance for schools. Read this in full on the link here: <u>Education</u> <u>settings: New National Restrictions from 5 November 2020</u>

Significant information for families are as follows:



- Schools remain open
- Staff should wear face coverings in communal areas
- Parents are advised to wear face covering on school sites
- Children whose GP confirms in writing they are clinically extremely vulnerable are advised not to attend
- Children who are clinically vulnerable or have underlying health conditions but are <u>not</u> clinically extremely vulnerable continue to attend
- No extra-curricular after school clubs are allowed during lockdown apart from those supporting parents going to work e.g. Breakfast Club
- Acorns and Breakfast Club will still continue to run during lockdown. DfE Guidance states, 'before and after school clubs should only do so where it is necessary to support parents to work
- Only essential visitors are allowed into the schools
