

A reminder about how it will work

This year we have gone 'online'. We had hoped that we could return to face to face meetings by the summer, but alas, this can not be the case. All consultations will be online via a video call with your child's class teacher using a Google Meet link. This will be sent by your class teacher on Monday. We



recommend that you test the link first, before the meeting time, to check it works on your device. Don't worry, nothing will happen, you will not see anyone on the link. But your device might instruct you to download updated software.

- 1. Click the link that directs you to an online Google Form.
- 2. Please complete and return your form, via the submit button, to your child's class teacher by 3.30pm on Monday 12th July
- 3. Class teachers will schedule your 10 minute appointment and send you an email notification.
- 4. At the allotted time on the night click the link and join the meeting with your child's teacher.

You can join the Google Meet link at any point before your allotted time slot. No one else has the same link as you. Your class teacher will then join you at the start of the appointment. DO NOT wait for a telephone call. Just open the link and wait for your class teacher to come online to join you.

Please note, timings will be strictly adhered to as other parents will be waiting for their appointment on another link.

Please also indicate on the form if you have other children at Woodcroft Primary School and which class they are in so that we can coordinate your appointments.
