

Updated COVID Organisation for September

We have had confirmed cases of COVID in the school already this term. Remember, if you test positive or suspect symptoms you MUST stay away from school! Those that need a test should book one immediately.

If family members or close contacts of a pupil test positive then you must book a text immediately for your child and keep them off school until your results are back. If your child's result is clear then they can return to school immediately. You do NOT need to self-isolate after you test negative.

Remember, you MUST book a PCR test for your child if they have been with a positive case.

COVID Safety Arrangements

We have retained many of our COVID sayfety arrangements to protect you and your child. These include:

- > Extended arrival times between 8.30am 8.55am remain (try to arrive by 8.45am)
- > Separate Year Group Breaks and Lunchtimes.
- > Collection queuing and one way systems.
- > We only allow two year groups to sit in the hall at the same time for assemblies and events.
- > We have dedicated year group cover staff to avoid transmission
- > Washing stations installed in every classroom
- Increased hygiene and cleaning

Nursery Places for September 2021


30 Hours FREE Childcare is available at Woodcroft Nursery

Arbor Parent Portal

We are putting everything for parents in one place within the **Arbor Parent Portal**.



You are now able to make online payments and see your child's information through the Arbor portal.

Most parents have already registered to access their account. Reminder emails have been sent to everyone who still needs to log on. If you have not registered, please check your inbox and junk folders for the welcome emails from Arbor.

The Arbor system will be used for Email, Messaging, Assessment Information, Behaviour Reports and now **Cashless Payments**. All this from one convenient and secure login!

IMPORTANT NOTE: The first time you log on you will need to use a computer, laptop or tablet.

Parents who have done this already report that it is quick and easy. However, some phones do not allow you to press the 'accept terms' button because of their screen size. However, once this is done for the first time they say that it is easy to login using your phone.

You can also download the Arbor App from the Google Play Store or the Apple App Store to easily log in to your school account.


