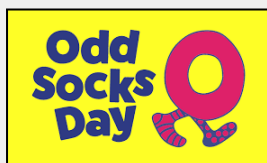

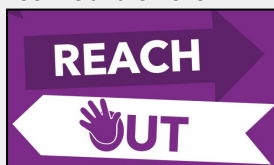

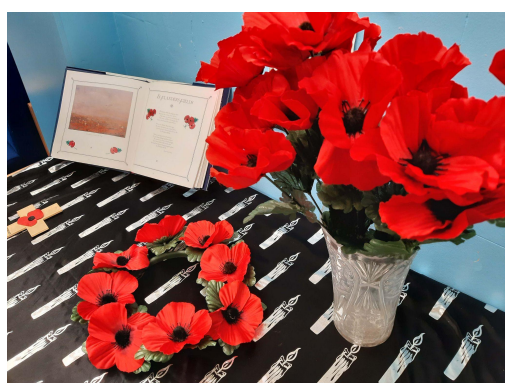

Healthy Eating in Y6 - A report by Alesia - 6K

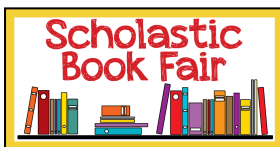

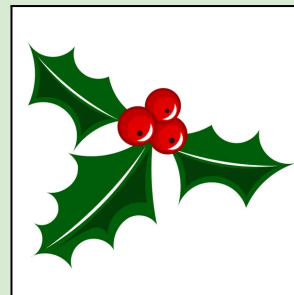
