'Parent Workshops' take place in school on Wednesday mornings from 9:00 – 10:00 am. A crèche will be available between 9:00am – 10:00am,


**'Stay & Play'** sessions on alternate Wednesdays give parents the opportunity to spend some time in class and observe lessons being taught.

## Free School Meals and Pupil Premium Funding: Do you qualify? If you do not declare your eligibility you are missing out!

Every half term we distribute vouchers for supermarkets. Before Christmas every child who qualified received a £42.30 voucher.

You are eligible if you receive any of the following:

- ➤ Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- > Income Support
- ➤ Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- > Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- > Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- > The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- > Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- > Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190 Contact the office today if you think you qualify. Do not miss out on your FREE vouchers!!!
