Year 4 Swimming Lessons Coming Soon



Year 4 will start an intensive swimming course immediately after the Easter Break from Tuesday 18th April. The lessons take place at the new Copthall Pool every morning until 29th April. They will be travelling there by coach. This is a compulsory unit of the national curriculum.

Pupils will need a suitable kit bag (not their school bag as it could get wet), a one piece swimming costume or trunks, a swimming hat (compulsory for both girls and boys), and a towel. Pupils are not allowed to wear two piece bikinis or long swimming shorts. It is also important to bring a warm jacket/coat for the journey. What reasons does the school accept for absence?

- Genuine illness
- Unavoidable medical/dental appointments.
- Day of religious observance
- Family bereavement
- Participation in approved public performance



Except in the case of illness, you should ask for permission for your child to be granted leave of absence well in advance, giving details of the reasons for your request. In cases of medical/dental appointments, please show the appropriate appointment card, message or letter, so it can be coded in the register and **children are expected to return to school** unless the appointment is late in the afternoon. In cases of recurring absences for illness, you may be asked to produce medical evidence.

Requests for a 'Leave of Absence'

If parents need to request a leave of absence from school for their child please obtain a form from the office. Please note all absence requests need to be approved by the Headteacher in advance.

It is common for Class Teachers to report that some children become very tired during the school day - this probably means they are not getting enough sleep. Tiredness can seriously affect your performance in school!

When we last surveyed our pupils we were surprised by the number who had access to devices and screens in their bedrooms at bedtime. Research shows that children aged 6 to 12 years old need between 9 and 12 hours of good sleep as part of a regular bedtime routine. **Most importantly, children should have all devices removed from their bedroom at night e.g. phones and tablets.**
