Twenty two of our pupils who went on to secondary school this term made an emotional return to Woodcroft on Wednesday evening. They were receiving their prestigious Bronze Arts Award Certificates. It was lovely to see so many of our ex year six pupils come back for this annual celebration.

To achieve the Bronze Arts Award, an Ofqual accredited national qualification, pupils presented detailed portfolios to an assessor from the prestigious Trinity College London. This showed they had taken part in arts activities, experienced art events, researched artists and shared new skills with others. Woodcroft staff are trained as Arts Award Advisers to be able to run this programme. Our current Year 6 are now being given the opportunity to obtain this nationally recognised qualification for themselves.
